

Montlure Overnight Camp MUSIC LEADER Job Description

Main Objective: The Montlure Volunteer Music & Worship Leader works cooperatively with the Montlure Chaplain to plan and lead campers in music during chapel times (two to three times per day). They engage with campers through music, worship, and shared experiences, fostering a Christ-centered community built on trust, openness, and connection. As a positive role model, they provide friendship, a listening ear, support, encouragement, understanding, and care. They serve with a loving attitude and a commitment to creating an environment where campers can encounter the love of God and explore their faith. Through music and worship, they help campers grow spiritually, physically, emotionally, and socially.

Reports To: Montlure Camp Director; Accountable to the Council of the Montlure Camp

Roles and Responsibilities

- Lead campers in worship through music and liturgy multiple times daily (typically 2–3 times)
- Work to achieve the program goals of the Montlure Camp Director that coordinate themes and Scripture of curriculum and overall camp schedule/structure
- Collaborate and communicate with the Chaplain for the week, as well as other staff members involved in helping with worship
- Work with the Chaplain to establish a clear vision for each worship service
- Primarily use music from the Montlure Song Book (but new music is welcomed!)
- Foster a strong sense of Christian community through music leadership in worship and daily camp life
- Cultivate a safe environment at all times for campers and staff to explore their faith
- Be a team player and enthusiastically assist with general camp tasks as needed
- Follow Montlure Policies and Procedures at all times
- Serve as a positive Christian role model, offering campers respect, support, understanding, and care
- Arrive a day early to camp for Volunteer Orientation & Training

Qualifications

- Comfortable leading group vocals in a worship setting
- Play an (unplugged) instrument that is helpful in leading music for the duration of camp week
- Ability to lead a long music worship service during our Jr High/Sr High weeks, "plugged in" (≈75 minutes)
- · Possess a growing, searching, tolerant Christian faith that guides one's daily life
- Able to work cooperatively with others including staff, volunteers, and campers
- Flexibility and adaptability in a dynamic camp environment
- Previous experience in leading music & worship
- Able to work and live in a rustic camp environment with daily exposure to varying weather conditions
- Possess the visual and auditory skills to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to camp activities
- Be willing to submit to a criminal background check
- 20 years of age or older
